LINKages Society of Alberta is a nonprofit organization that provides programs and services that encourage young people to connect with seniors in ways that are mutually beneficial.

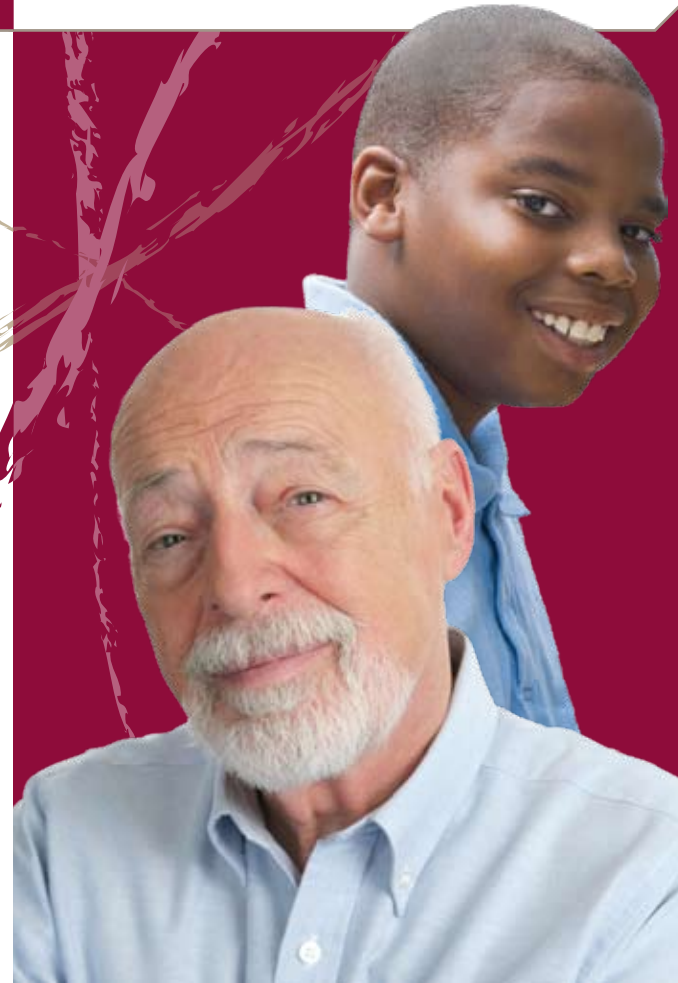

Our Vision

To be a leader in the development, operation, promotion and expansion of intergenerational programs (IGPs).



Our Mission

To foster friendships between youth and seniors to enhance their personal strengths and quality of life by providing intergenerational programs and services.



School Programs

Our staff are dedicated to creating various ways of bringing generations together. LINKages works with several public and separate schools to create programs that encourage young people to meet with seniors residing in long-term care facilities. Youth volunteers participate in training and orientation sessions to learn about seniors' health issues, care facility policies and procedures, as well as individual expectations.

Junior High

- Visits take place bi-weekly over the lunch hour
- Transportation is provided both ways
- Many visits have planned activities
- Supervision and support provided as students may be new to volunteering
- Two students are matched with one senior

Senior High

- Visits are on their own time, usually after school and on the weekends
- LINKages' staff provides support with ongoing information and evaluations.
- Two students are matched with one senior

Young Adults Connecting with Seniors (YACS)

This program was designed as an extension of our high school programs by encouraging post-secondary students to reach out in the community to volunteer with isolated or lonely seniors who live independently or in senior residences. The YACS program focuses on connecting two generations to enhance healthier living. New collaborative partnerships with post-secondary institutions and senior assistance programs are ongoing.

Benefits of YACS

- Introduction to the emerging field of intergenerational studies to post-secondary students
- Allows young adults the chance to learn, share and appreciate the life experience of a senior
- Seniors discover a new sense of purpose sharing their personal stories and experiences
